The NEF's involvement in this project is not only a celebration of black women entrepreneurship but also a strategic investment in one of South Africa's key provinces. Limpopo, identified as one of six priority provinces for the NEF's disbursements, has been targeted for its vast potential in driving economic growth and development. This investment is particularly significant as it aligns with the NEF's mission to support projects that stimulate local economies and create sustainable job opportunities.
